1) A copy of a current Minnesota Permit To Purchase a handgun or a current Minnesota Permit to Carry a handgun must accompany this application. A permit to purchase a rifle or shotgun cannot be accepted. An annual permit to purchase a handgun can be obtained without charge from the Law Enforcement Agency that would respond to your home for a 911 call.

2) Applications will only be accepted December 1st through July 31st. Induction meetings are held January through August. Therefore, applications received after the August induction will not be Processed until after December 1st.

Currently, applicants are inducted at the membership meetings held on the third Tuesday of the month in the Banquet Room of the Hugo American Legion. For the months of January through March, meetings start at 7PM. During the shooting months of April through August, the meetings begin at 8:00 PM. This meeting usually adjourns within a half-hour.

A photo ID badge will be mailed after you complete the range orientation session. These are usually held on the Saturday following the induction meeting in the Rifle Range Building at 10 AM and typically last around an hour and a half. If you are unable to attend the Saturday session, an alternative session must be arranged with the Chief Range Officer.

Spouses and minor children may use the range with the member and shoot at member fees. The member must be on the range with them. The range is open year around. Hours are Mon-Fri 8AM-8PM and Sat 10AM-5PM. The firearm ranges are closed most Sundays. Hugo requires we close the firearm ranges Memorial Day weekend, the entire week of Fourth-of-July and Labor Day weekend.

The membership is primarily responsible for the running of the club. Work time service of 8 hours yearly is required of members, however a member may buyout the work hours at the rate of \$30 for each of the 8 hours not worked. The club has an online work hour reservation system which makes it easy to schedule work time. A user name and password will be emailed after you have been inducted.

A \$100 initiation fee and full dues of \$75 are required of new members. Payment is made at the induction meeting. Do not send any payment at this time.

A detailed confirming letter will be sent after this application is received.
